Uniform Design Contest

Global Skills Park (GSP), is a new-age world class technical training institution for providing career cluster curriculum skilling courses and opportunities of overseas employment, is getting established in Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh, India. GSP will provide world-class technical training in precision engineering sector with six career oriented trades namely Conventional Lathe, Conventional Milling, CNC Milling, CNC Turning, Surface Grinding and Machining and Metrology with soft skills add on courses like IT Skills and Communication Skills.

Global Skills Park, will open admission for its first batch 2018-2019 from 16th May 2018 to 15th June 2018. The annual session of GSP will commence on 1st August 2018 onwards. The eligibility requirements for admission in GSP are:-

1. 10th Pass ITI passed students
2. B.E graduates/Diploma
3. Industry employed

The objectives of GSP include:

- a. Establish internationally recognized standards in management, teaching quality, training infrastructure, and curriculum content in Madhya Pradesh and use it as a model to stimulate improvement in all TVET institutions;
- b. Produce occupation-ready skilled workers in accordance with cluster- sector approach in design, thinking and delivery;
- c. Strengthen linkages and cooperation with industries through either partnership training in GSP and / or various structured apprenticeship programs; and

d. To be truly global in perspective, GSP will stimulate and enhance innovations in skills development through international and national research, analysing future skills need, introducing lifelong learning concepts, and improve productivity through innovative training in products and processes.

Background

An open national design contest is conducted by Global Skills Park under Department of Technical Education, Skill Development & Employment to select best uniform design for upcoming new batch of India's first Global Skills Park, in Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh.

Contest Eligibility

1. Undergraduate/ Post Graduate Design students in their final year
2. Fashion Design graduates
3. Practicing professional fashion designers/ Fashion Labels
4. Fashion Industry/Label organization, start-ups etc.
5. Freelance Designers

Design Brief:

1. A uniform for classroom and add-on workshop attire needs to be designed separately for Boys and Girls of age 15 years and above. The cost of both Boys & Girls uniform with add on attire should not exceed Rs. 2000 each.
2. The uniform must have top and bottom for both boys and girls. Functional pockets are preferred but not mandatory.
3. Participants must use a comfortable fabric as per the standards of international industrial training environment.

Contest Submission Rules:

1. Participants should submit their both uniform designs with workshop attire in sketches as a scanned large resolution JPEG or PDF File.
2. Back, Front and side view of the uniform should be included in the submission.
3. Technical description of colour combination used in uniform and fabric material used should be described in the design submitted
4. Written statement in Hindi/English with minimum 200 words summarising your design concept must be submitted.
5. Each participant can submit only one entry. Multiple entries will disqualify the participant. The first entry submitted by participant will be considered.

6. Candidates will have to submit their Design degree/ company profile/college certificate to prove eligibility clause. Candidates will have to give a written letter to the concerned department stating that the design of the uniform is their own and is not a copy. Any kind of infringement will disqualify the contestant.

Selection Procedure:

- A. This will be a two stage contest. In Stage One participants need to make submission of Uniform Design Sketches with detail of fabric and colour code used at gsp.uniformcontest@gmail.com
- B. For Stage Two: The top seven shortlisted entries selected from Stage one will be required to present tailored uniform with two models (boy & girl) before the panel of jury. The selection will be purely based on creativity, comfort and professional acceptability.
- C. The contest is open to multi-disciplinary teams led by an established Fashion Designer/ Label. As per the jury of Global Skills Park one finalist will be selected based on the presentation of the uniform, comfort of the uniform and practical acceptability of the uniform in industrial training scenario .Finalists will be contacted individually by mobile and email.

Note:

1. The selected designers will be required to submit one set of completed outfit for screening at a Meet-The-Jury session. Outfits that do not meet the judges' required standard will be rejected.
2. All submitted garments must be produced in accordance with the original submitted design sketches

Prize Money

The top three winners will be eligible for awards of Rs. 1,00,000

1. This contest is open to all residents of the country except employees and families of Department of Technical Education, Skill Development & Employment and family members of jury or anyone connected with the contest.
2. No entry fee is required to enter this contest.
3. Participants cannot submit more than one entry. It may lead to disqualification of other design submitted by participants.
4. Closing date for the contest is **20th May 2018** for stage one online submission and stage two final submission and presentation date is **15th June 2018**. The winners will be announced on **20th June 2018**.
5. All designs submitted must be original and have never been represented or used by anyone before.
6. Designs infringing on existing copyrights will lead to disqualification and Global Skills Park shall not be liable for any dispute.
7. Winner of the contest will be chosen by an independent jury panel appointed by Global Skills Park.
8. Global Skills Park reserves right to amend or cancel the contest and terms & conditions without any prior notice.
9. The winner will be announced on during the final contest day and notified by phone/email or letter by 7 days of the finals. If the winner cannot be contacted or do not claim the prize within 7 days of notification, we reserve the right to withdraw the prize from the winner and pick a replacement winner.
10. Global Skills Park decision in respect of all matters to do with the contest will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
11. By entering this contest, the participants agrees to all the terms and conditions.
12. The winner agrees to the use of his/her name and image in any publicity material.
13. All designs submitted in the contest shall be intellectual property of Global Skills Park, who shall have full right to use the design anywhere in the city.
